



Dragons are the fire-breathing fiends of a thousand travelers' tales, the most feared of the fantastical beasts said to roam the Hârn wilderness. Legends tell of the Great Wyrn that emerges from its lair to devour an entire village or just one helpless maiden. While many such tales can be discounted as the ravings of madmen or acts of human cruelty or nature's fury, others are based on actual sightings and encounters.

There are two distinct types of dragon found on Hârn, although there is some debate among scholars over whether they are truly different species. *Ahnerin* (fire dragons) and *Dhiverin* (ice dragons) share many of the same characteristics and abilities. However, they can be readily identified by their distinctive coloration and choice of habitat. Most of all, they can be distinguished by their fearsome breath weapon.

There may be other species of dragon as well. The forest-dwelling dragons of eastern Lythia seem very different from their western cousins. Further, some among the Shek-Pvar insist that there exist dragons linked to each of the Pvaric elements and that those found on Hârn are but two of the six varieties. Whether these claims can be trusted is in doubt. Indeed, whether these reports even represent true dragons is unknown.

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
